IBL (Istituto Bruno Leoni, www.brunoleoni.it) wishes to invite you to contribute a paper to the **2009 Mises Seminar**, to be held in Sestri Levante (Italy), October 9th - 11th.

Submitting authors should be **younger than 35 years old**.

The general theme discussed in the submitted essays will be the following:

Rewarding Innovation. How a Market Economy Should Compensate the Entrepreneurial Spirit.

The topic can be investigated from the perspective of economics, philosophy, law, sociology, history, economic history.

Authors are invited to submit a proposal of about **500 words**, in English to Dr Carlo Lottieri (carlo.lottieri@brunoleoni.it) not later than **February 28th, 2009**.

IBL will then select the best submissions and inform the candidates accordingly **by March 30**. Conference paper (max. length 40.000 characters, in English) are to be submitted to IBL by **July 1st 2009**.

All travel and boarding expenses of the selected authors will be paid for by Istituto Bruno Leoni.
